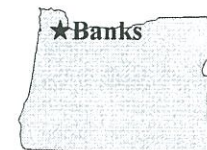
The Banks School District Board of Directors is searching for a highly qualified candidate with exceptional leadership skills and successful experience in K-12 education and administration to serve as their next superintendent. The successful candidate must have excellent communication skills, an open and honest management style, unquestionable integrity and be willing to be involved in the community. The current superintendent is retiring at the end of the 2011-12 school year, after 32 years of service at the district (the last three years as superintendent).

Banks School District serves approximately 1,100 students in one elementary school (K-6), one middle school (7-8) and one high school (9-12). The district employs 59 licensed staff, 39 classified/support staff, four confidential staff and six administrative staff and has a general fund budget of approximately \$8.5 million and a total budget in excess of \$11.7 million.

Banks School District is a rural district that stretches 20 miles from east to west and approximately 18 miles north to south, encompassing 450 square miles. Most of the surrounding land is farm and forest land. Agriculture and timber are the main industries within the district, however, the majority of the population is employed in areas outside the community. The town of Banks has a population of 1,400 but the resident population within the district is approximately 4,500. Banks is nestled in scenic Oregon wine country between the Cascade Mountains and the Oregon Coast Range, approximately 25 miles west of Portland, Oregon's largest city.

The Board will offer a competitive compensation package to the successful candidate. The successful candidate must hold or qualify for an Oregon superintendent's license.
