Winter Sports Protocols

- Thirty-five percent capacity.
- All fans will be seated upstairs.
- Players, coaches, workers, cheer & pom allowed on the floor.
- Limited number of students allowed in student seating.
- Masks are required while inside the Performing Arts & Athletics (PAAC) facility.
- 12 total cheer/pom allowed on the floor at any given time. Rotation is allowed by quarter or half periods. Masks are worn at all times.
- Entire cheer/pom group is allowed to perform at halftime. Masks are optional during the performance.
- Wrestling: Four cheer/pom allowed on the mat at any given time.
- Please follow CDC guidelines that stress the importance of masking properly, physical distancing, and frequent hand washing and sanitizing.



Deer Creek Athletics Event Guidelines

Dear Student-Athletes, Coaches, Staff, Officials, Administrators, Parents and Patrons:

First off, we would like to welcome you to our facilities! As we navigate through these uncertain times during the COVID-19 pandemic, we would like you to know that the health and safety of all student-athletes, coaches, staff, officials, administrators, parents and patrons are our priority.

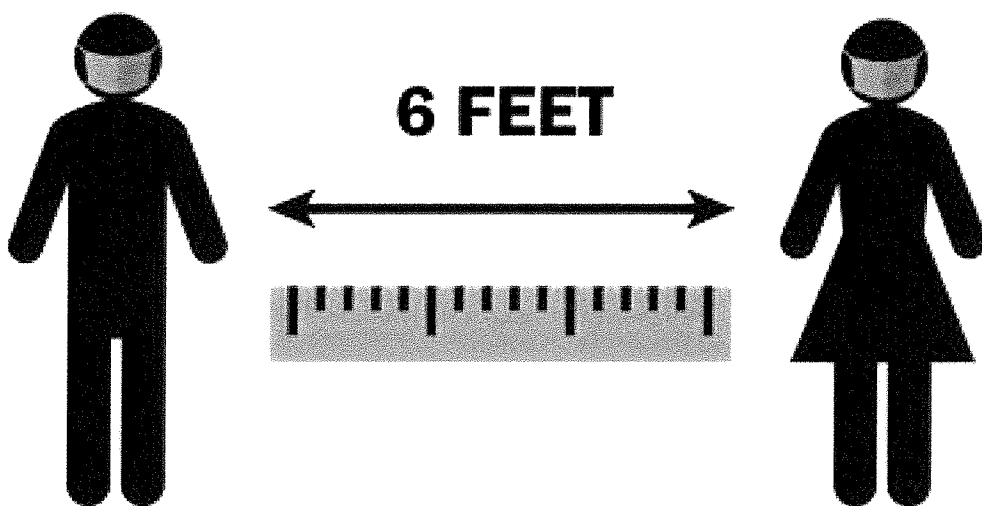
Below are our Deer Creek Athletic Event Guidelines:

1. Mask or face coverings are required for all participants, coaches, workers, officials, patrons or anyone entering a Deer Creek Public Schools Facility. Refusal to wear a mask or face covering will prevent admittance into the facility.
2. Participants, officials and coaches may remove their masks when they reach their respective playing field or court (ex: volleyball: on the court, softball: inside the playing field fence). Face coverings are encouraged but not required inside the playing field.
3. Make every effort to have exact change for gate and concession transactions. Gate entry is \$5.00 for adults and students 1st grade and up. Ticket sellers and concession workers will be masked and gloved, and behind a Plexiglas partition. We would like to limit exchanges between patrons and workers while promoting social distancing with limited gatherings in both areas.
4. All non-participants will be required to wear masks/face coverings at all times and maintain social distance when possible.
5. While we believe sportsmanship is a paramount to the development of young people, at this time, we will recommend no pre-game or post-game hand shaking, high-fives, or fist bumps between opposing teams to reduce contact as much as possible.
6. At some of our venues, there will be seating areas marked off as unavailable. Please refrain from sitting in these areas to help keep our student-athletes, coaches and officials as safe as possible.
7. For participants, officials and coaches, no shared towels, clothing, shoes or water bottles.
8. For shared equipment, such as bats, helmets, catchers gear, etc., sanitation should occur in between use when necessary.
9. Locker rooms will be accessible to teams but we highly recommend, for both home and visiting teams and officials, to come dressed and ready to participate for the event. Masks will be required in locker rooms, athletic training rooms and coaches' offices and any area considered outside of the playing field or court. Locker rooms will be sanitized prior to and after occupancy.
10. Concession stands will be selling only prepackaged items such as candy bars, chips, crackers, etc. All beverages will be in bottles.

11. Only necessary personnel will be allowed in the press box and at scorer's tables.
12. When trading teams benches, such as in between volleyball sets, chairs should be sanitized.
13. When traveling to and from away events, all Deer Creek coaches and student-athletes will be required to wear face coverings.
