

PURCELL PUBLIC SCHOOLS COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS(Indoors)

November 2, 2020

Face Coverings (masks, gaiters, shields, etc.) are required at all times while inside PPS athletic facilities:

Exceptions to wearing a face covering: Students who are actively participating, children under school age, and those individuals with medical documentation that states they should not wear a face covering.

For the safety of everyone we request that you follow the guidelines below:

1. We ask that spectators exercise physical distancing of at least 6ft per Center of Disease Control guidelines. These guidelines can be found [here](#).
2. While we believe sportsmanship is paramount to the development of young people, at this time we will recommend no hand shaking between opposing teams.
3. At some of our venues, there may be seats marked off as unavailable. Please refrain from sitting in these areas as they help to maintain social distancing
4. For participants, coaches, and officials, no shared water bottles, towels clothing, or equipment.
5. We request that participants bring their own personal water bottle.
6. Teams will need to bring their own warm-up balls. Game balls will be provided and sanitized after each game.
7. Only necessary personnel will be allowed at the scorers table and in the concession stand.
8. Locker rooms will be accessible to teams but we highly recommend, for both visiting and home teams and officials, to come dressed and ready to participate for the event. Masks should be worn inside the locker rooms. Locker rooms will be sanitized prior to and after occupancy.
9. Children will not be allowed to play in the commons area. Children should remain seated with their parents.
10. Loitering in the commons area will not be allowed before, during, or after games. As soon as an event has concluded, please make your way to the exits immediately.
11. We request that everyone conduct a COVID-19 self screening assessment prior to entering. If you have a fever, sore throat, loss of smell or taste, or cough, please stay home.
12. We request you use hand sanitizer before entering. Sanitizer will be available at the door and concession area
13. Spectators will not be allowed during practices.
