

BASKETBALL GUIDELINES-PROTOCOLS

The Lucky 7 Conference and the Quapaw Board of Education has approved guidelines and protocols for student and spectator safety for the 2020-21 season. Our number one goal is to have our students compete and play basketball this season. With this goal, all of us have to do our part to make this happen in the safest possible environment. We want to give our basketball teams and cheerleaders the season they deserve. Here are the protocols and guidelines for basketball in Quapaw and throughout the Lucky 7 schools:

- *Masks will be mandatory in all indoor facilities. (Gymnasiums/Lobby/Snack Bar Area/Rest Rooms).*
- *Following CDC guidelines, masks will be required (masks should not be worn by children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing, anyone who is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance) for indoor activities where social distancing is not possible.*
- *Persons not complying with this requirement will be treated as an unruly fan and will be removed from the facility.*
- *No outside food or drinks will be allowed in the facilities.*
- *No one will be allowed on the court except players, coaches, officials, cheerleaders, game workers, and administration.*
- *There will be no fundraising activities on the basketball court.*
- *These guidelines will include youth basketball, MS basketball and HS basketball.*
